Dear Parents and Guardians,

This letter is to inform you that there are students in the Grade School that have severe, life threatening allergies to nuts.

To ensure a safe classroom environment, we will implement a few very important considerations for these children.

To comply with the District's Allergy Policy 5422R, the classroom in which a food allergic student attends class will be maintained safe. Because of the risk, we are requiring a nut free snack for the classroom, including those provided for parties and celebrations.

Home baked goods and other foods prepared at home should not be sent into the classroom of a food allergic child. Food brought in for special events in the classroom should be purchased in stores, commercially prepared and contain a complete ingredient list.

It is difficult at the best of times to get children to eat healthy snacks; however, I hope you will appreciate the seriousness of this condition and that you will assist us in our efforts to create as safe an environment as possible.

With your cooperation, we can minimize the risk of a serious allergic reaction.
