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2017 Babylon Little League Registration

Babylon Village Little League is conducting **Spring registrations exclusively online!** Sign up at www.babylonlittleleague.org.

Registrations completed on or before 12/15 receive a \$10 discount.

Late registrations (after January 31st) which will require the approval of the Babylon Little League Board of Directors will be charged an additional \$25 late fee per player.

All registrants must provide a copy of their birth certificate, even if the player has previously registered with the league.

Registration fees for baseball and softball include jersey, hat and socks.

T-ball (league ages 5 & 6) = \$110 per player
Farms (league ages 7 & 8) = \$140 per player
Minors (league ages 9 & 10) = \$160 per player
Majors (league ages 11 & 12) = \$160 per player
Juniors, Seniors Baseball - Summer (ages 13-18) = \$295 per player
Juniors, Seniors Softball (ages 13-16) = \$190 per player

Babylon Little League will be holding several FREE clinics throughout the year to all players starting January 22nd. Clinic attendees must be registered for the Spring 2017 season to participate. If registered after January 22nd there will be a fee for clinics as well as a late registration fee.

So register EARLY to save money and be part of our informative clinics.

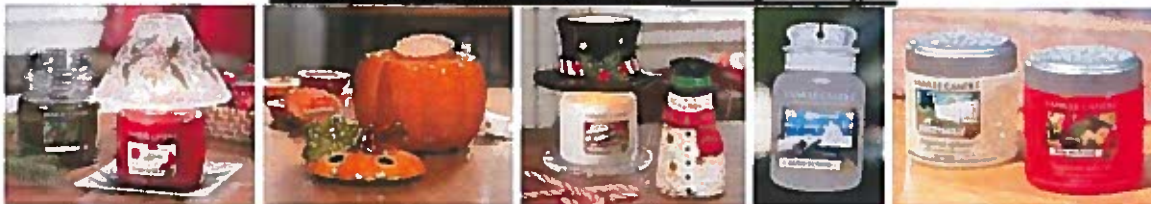

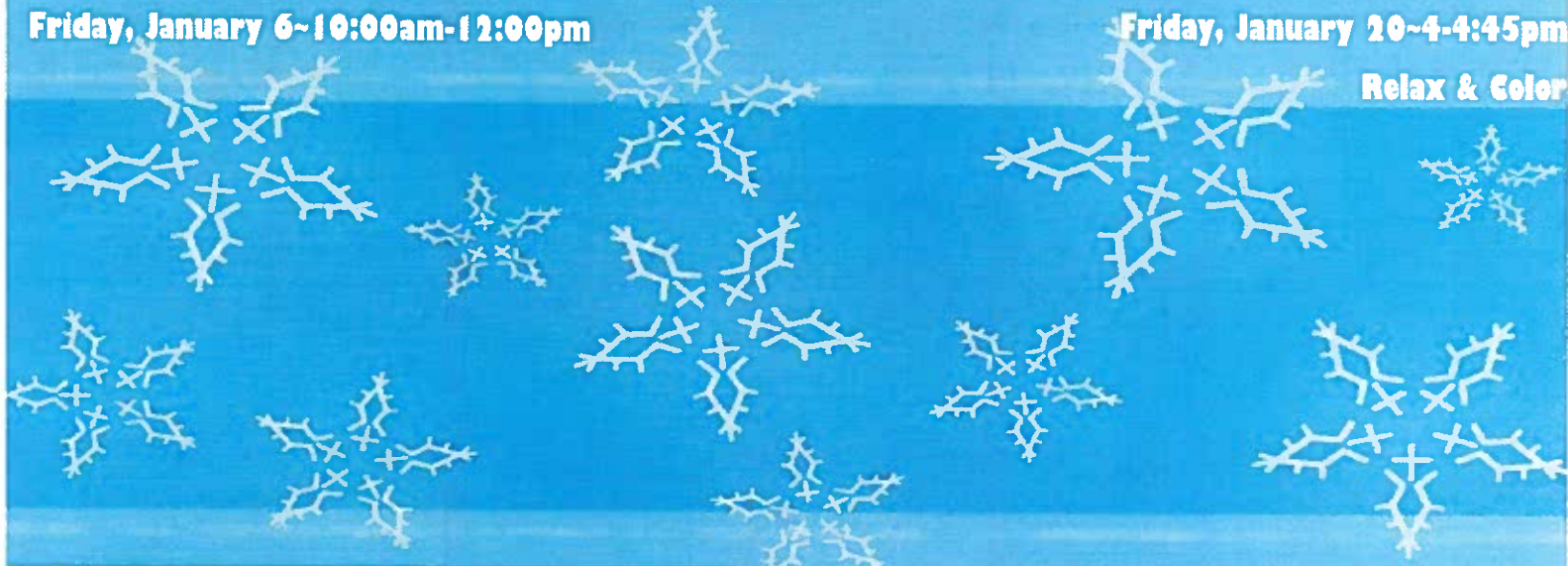
