Dear Parents,

The Babylon School District After School Program would like to take this opportunity to inform you that the **4th session** of the integrated after school program will begin **on Monday, May 1, 2017**. The purpose of the program is to give our students extended opportunities to interact with each other in a social yet structured setting that will enhance the development and improvement of skills that are necessary to be lifelong learners. **We are always looking for students who are interested in becoming peer mentors, role models or have an interest in community service and helping others. Yes, future leaders, the afterschool program needs you!** To those students who are currently participating and to those who have done so in the past, it is with great pleasure to extend our congratulations to you! **We are extremely proud of you!**

The program is run by a certified special education teacher one hour afterschool four days a week; Monday through Thursday. Ending times will be 3:45 at the elementary school and 3:40 at the grade school. Grade School students are located in Room 41 and Elementary School students are located in Room D2.

The program consists of the following:

- Two days will focus on social skills. As social skills are facilitated, students will profit from the development and improvement of cooperative and collaborative skills that will benefit them throughout their lives. Another added benefit is the development of long-lasting friendships that would not be otherwise possible
- Two days a week will focus on homework strategies. Focus will be on teaching strategies that will facilitate successful completion of homework at home. Strategies include but not limited to, organizational skills, study skills, reading activities, etc.
- Students and teachers will participate in collaborative activities

Dear Parents:

Upon the passing of the school budget, the Babylon district will once again offer a summer instrumental music program. This wonderful program is available to two sets of music students at Babylon Memorial GS: **Beginning** Band students and **returning** String students.

Registration information for **beginning** band students will be sent home in May, and they will be assigned their instrument before the end of the school year. **String students entering 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade** will be eligible to participate in the summer program.
