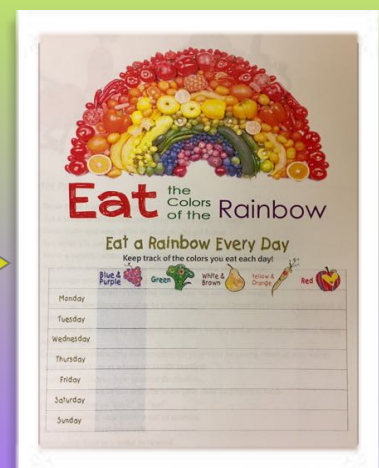
## 3-D Assembly Kicks Off Eat the Rainbow Week
