WORK/STUDY DISCUSSION

Mrs. Rozzi, Superintendent of Schools, presented a power point on the district goals. The goals are posted on the district website.

The Board of Education discussed some of the goals presented.

Mrs. Pané, President, reported that Mr. Robertson, transportation consultant, will be reporting sometime in November. The Board of Education asked Mr. Robertson to explore the following:

- ➤ K-6 Scenarios (currently at .75 or more from home to measuring point). What would be the extra costs in physical Fleet as well as estimated loss in state aid for each of the following scenarios:
 - .5 miles home to school;
 - .25 miles home to school;
 - Universal K-6 bussing for all K-6 students
- > 7-12 Scenarios (Currently at 3.0 miles or more from home to school) What would be the extra costs in physical Fleet as well as estimated loss in state aid for each of the following scenarios:
 - 1 mile home to school;
 - .75 miles home to school:
 - .5 miles home to school
- Universal Bussing 7-12.
 - What would be the extra costs in physical fleet as well as estimated loss in state aid;
 - Costs in doing K-12 universal bussing (cost of additional fleet) plus estimated total loss in state aid.
