SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mr. Conboy reported the following: Mr. Conboy noted that there were not a lot of community members present, possibly due to the weather. He went on to say that he hoped everybody had a healthy and restful winter break. We've had a very mild winter up until now but today it looks like there is a storm coming our way. We are aware that some districts have already put in for a two-hour delay, but we are not going to make any decision like that until morning, but we will keep a good eye on the weather and what it brings us.

The real order of business here in the district for the next six weeks, between now and April 10th, April 10th being the day the Board votes on the School's budget adoption for the 2023-2024 school year, will be the budget. That will be just a 15-minute early dismissal for all students and staff. We will put out reminders between now and March 31st.

March is also PARP month. We have a couple of concerts coming up, the Pops concerts, which are happening next week. Spring athletics start two weeks from today, March 13th. And as of today, we have seventy-six instructional days to go in this school year.
